## **NATIONAL VISA FOR “FAMILY REASONS” WITH THE AUTHORISATION (NULLA OSTA) FROM THE SINGLE IMMIGRATION WINDOW (SUI)**

### **Documents required for the visa application**

Documents required for the application for a national visa for family reunification on “FAMILY REASONS” with family members of foreign nationals lawfully resident in Italy.

The visa application for the family member residing in Turkey may be submitted once the citizen legally resident in Italy has obtained the authorisation issued by the competent local Prefecture.

- National visa application form (type D), completed, dated and signed in section 37 and on the last page.
- 1 recent passport-sized photograph with a light background, measuring 35 x 40 mm ([ICAO](#)).
- Passport valid for at least 3 months beyond the expiry date of the visa applied for. Photocopy of the passport and any previous passports (pages containing personal details and all pages with stamps or visas).
- A copy of the Turkish identity card bearing the national identity number. For applicants of other nationalities, a copy of the Turkish residence permit.
- Historical residence certificate with a barcode obtained from e-devlet.
- Family status certificate with a barcode obtained from e-devlet or, if from a third country, translated into Italian and legalised.
- A letter of invitation from the Italian or EU family member stating their intention to exercise the right to family reunification, accompanied by a valid identity document.
- Civil status documents certifying family relationship (e.g. Form B) or a marriage certificate or civil partnership certificate. If these documents originate from a third country, they must be translated into Italian and legalised.
- Photocopy of the authorization - ‘Nulla Osta’ issued by the Prefecture – S.U.I. (Single Immigration Desk).
- Photocopy of the valid Residence Permit of the family member residing in Italy.
- Proof of financial support where required: evidence of financial remittances from the Italian/EU citizen demonstrating ongoing financial support sufficient to enable the beneficiary to meet their basic needs.
- Booking confirmation for outbound flights; for applicants intending to travel by land using private transport, a description of the itinerary is required. ‘Interrail’ journeys must be documented, and visa offices may require the ticket to be booked in advance.
- Visa application processing fees to be paid in cash in Turkish lira at iData offices.

## **Additional documents required**

### **Spouse**

- Marriage certificate or civil partnership certificate (Form B). If these documents originate from a third country, they must be translated into Italian and legalised.

**Minor children** (*who have not reached the age of 18 at the time of submitting the application for authorisation to the SUI*)

- Certificate of family status.
- Birth certificate.
- For minors travelling with only one parent, consent from the other parent (not more than 3 months old), notarised and apostilled (Muvafakatname). Please note that border police may request to see the consent document in Italian or English.
- In the absence of consent from the other parent who has waived or lost parental authority due to sole custody: a judgement from the competent court recognising sole custody, translated and apostilled.
- For minors travelling without parents, in addition to the muvafakatname from both parents, an apostilled declaration of accompaniment (or taking charge) (Taahhütname). Please note that border police may request to see the declaration of accompaniment in Italian or English.
- If one of the parents remains in Turkey whilst only the child is moving, this situation must be specified in the Muvafakatname consent form.
- For children of divorced parents: the consent of the other parent who is not moving must include consent to the child's move to Italy

### **Parents**

#### **For parents under the age of 65**

- Proof of financial support: evidence of financial remittances from a family member residing in Italy, demonstrating ongoing financial support that enables the beneficiary to meet their basic needs.
- SGK registration document (SGK tescil ve hizmet dökümü) with a legible QR code.
- Bank statement showing account transactions over the last six months.
- Appropriate documentation proving that the applicant has no other children in their country of origin. If the applicant has children outside their country of origin, the relevant certificate of residence may be attached.
- Pension certificate, if applicable.

#### **For parents aged over 65**

- Parents must prove that they have no other children in their country of origin; or, if they do have other children, it must be demonstrated that the latter are unable to care for their parents due to serious health reasons, duly documented.
