STUDY – GENERAL

for stays up to 90 days and for study activities other than university courses

Required Documents for the visa application

- Schengen visa application form, completed, dated, and signed at item 37 and on the last page
- A recent passport-sized photo with a light background, dimensions 35 x 40 mm (ICAO)
- Passport issued within the last 10 years, valid for at least 15 months beyond the expiration date of the requested visa, and with at least two blank pages
- Copy of the Turkish identity card bearing the national identity number. For applicants of different nationalities, a copy of a valid Turkish residence permit
- Historical certificate of residence with a barcode, obtained from e-devlet
- Family registry certificate with a barcode, obtained from e-devlet
- For minors: birth certificate
- For minors: parental consent (not older than 3 months) authenticated by a notary and apostilled (Muvafakatname)
- For minors: nominate a suitable guardian in Italy also according to Italian law, drawn up in the forms provided by Turkish law, apostilled, and accompanied by a sworn translation into Italian
- Certificate of enrollment in the course of study, or documentation relating to the cultural activity intended to be carried out. In any case, the documentation must clearly state the type of course or activity, as well as the start and end dates of the programs
- **Occupation.** Documentation regarding occupation of the applicant or, if the student is a dependent of their parents or a guardian, documentation regarding the occupation of the parents or guardian
- **Financial resources of subsistence** for the planned stay. Documentation regarding financial position of the applicant or, if the student is a dependent of their parents or a guardian, documentation regarding the financial position of the parents or guardian: bank statement, stamped and signed by the bank, showing transactions from the last six months (preferably with salary credits), income tax returns, pay slips from the last three months (stamped and signed), pension credits, lease agreements, property deeds, statements from the last six months of an international credit card, or proof of other personal financial resources (e.g., a scholarship)



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If the student is a dependent of their parents or a guardian, the latter must submit a letter of guarantee for the coverage of expenses, signed by the parent or guardian, along with a copy of their ID/document

Documents (including bank statements) in languages other than Italian, Turkish, or English must be accompanied by an official translation

- **Availability of suitable accommodation in the national territory.** The student must prove that they have a valid hotel reservation, an already concluded and duly registered lease agreement, a suitable declaration of hospitality (invitation letter) accompanied by a copy of the signatory's ID document, or the availability of accommodation at a university residence
- **Travel health insurance** with coverage of **not less than 30,000 Euros**, valid for the entire period of stay in European Union countries, for any medical and emergency expenses, hospitalization, and repatriation due to illness or death (Art. 39, paragraph 3 of the Consolidated Law [T.U.] No. 286/1998 and Directive dated 01.03.2000 of the Ministry of the Interior)
- **Booking of round-trip flights;** for applicants intending to travel by land using private vehicles, a **description of the itinerary** is required
- **Visa application processing fees** to be paid in cash in Turkish Lira at the iData offices
